

Southend Diving Skills Team take on the best from London's and South East Region diving clubs.

On Sunday 8th May 2016 twenty one divers who make up the Southend Diving Skills Team travelled to the K2 Leisure Centre Crawley to take on the best divers from London and South East Regions top diving clubs.

The day's events organised by the Amateur Swimming Association South East Region attracted over one hundred and sixty divers attempting to qualify for the National Skills Finals which will be held this year on 2nd and 3rd July 2016 at the Swimming and Diving Centre in Garon Park, Southend.

There were fantastic performances from the Southend Diving Team throughout the day with John Wylie and Noah Allende leading the way by showing their class with Gold and Bronze medal performances in the boys 9/11 years age group.

Great individual performances were also delivered by Evie Gibson Silver medal and Lilly Maggs bronze medal girls 9/11 years, Liam Ring Silver medal boys 12/13 years, Ceri Ewing Silver medal girls 14/16 years and Josiah Maggs Silver medal boys 14/16 yrs.

The three club coaches attending, Ian Macleod, Aaron Paul and James Hadley, all agree that this was an excellent day for the Southend Diving Team, seventeen of the twenty one skills divers have now qualified to compete at the National Skills Finals at their home pool at Southend in July.
